SUNDAY CLASS STUDY

THINGS CHRISTIANS SHOULD PRAY FOR - 3

Text: Col. 1:9-10

Introduction: For the past two weeks, we have been looking at the proper way Christians should pray that will match the will of God. This is one of the factors that separate the baby from mature Christians. In conclusion of our study, we are going to see the last two prayer focus that we should always be praying for.

- 1. Christians need to pray for others and not just for themselves
- 2. Christians should pray that they will be filled with the knowledge of God's will
- 3. Christians should pray for wisdom
- 4. Christians should pray that they have spiritual knowledge
- 5. Christians should pray that they will walk worthy of the Lord
- 6. Christians should pray that their worthy walk will fully please God
- 7. Christians should pray that they will be fruitful in every good work (v10) Jesus teaches that He is the vine and that each Christian is a branch (John 15:5,8). Jesus is clearly saying that Christians are to bear much fruit; otherwise, a Christian is not His disciple. The primary fruit of a Christian is another Christian. Christians need to stay busy trying to work with and teach and convert others to become New Testament

Christians and not just Churchgoers.

8. Christians should pray that they continually increase in their knowledge of God (v10) - The prayer that Paul is speaking of about "increasing in the knowledge of God" is different than what Paul was praying about in the middle of verse nine when he prayed for Christians to "be filled with the knowledge of God's will." "To be filled with the knowledge of God's will" means first and foremost to learn as much as possible of God's word from an intellectual standpoint. In contrast, to pray "to increase in the knowledge of God" means for us to be more and more obedient to God.

Monday's Path: Job 2:9 Then his wife said to him, "Do you still hold fast to your integrity? Curse God and die!"

PathWay: To Job's wife, his situation seemed hopeless. Painful sores covered his body. He had lost his possessions, and his children had died. Facing devastation, Jesus' name. PRAY! he sat among ashes. But despite all he suffered, Job still clung to his "integrity." The world is filled with people who urge us to compromise and give in to temptation. Yet, every day, we have the opportunity to demonstrate what we think answered Job out of the whirlwind, and and show whether we really believe in God and His Word.

*O Lord, help me keep my integrity in this unfaithful world in Jesus' name; PRAY! Tuesday's Path: Job 4:7 "Remember now, who ever perished being innocent? Or PathWay: Both times God spoke to Job, He where were the upright ever cut off?

v8 Even as I have seen, Those who plow iniquity And sow trouble reap the same. PathWay: After hearing of Job's tragedies, three friends came to comfort him. When they saw him, they were shocked and began to weep. Overwhelmed, no one spoke for days. Eliphaz was the first friend to speak. He initially might have been motivated by sympathy, but these feelings seem strangely absent from his words. Instead, his comments seem to have been speaking out of a spirit of spiritual arrogance like most Christians today.

*O Lord, give the spirit of humbleness in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Wednesday's Path: Job 26:7 He stretches out the north over empty space; He hangs the earth on nothing.

PathWay: Job may not have been scientifically advanced, but he observed the skies. Job was less concerned about the mechanics of stars and planets and more amazed by the miracle of creation. To him, the heavens pointed to God Himself. Think about the mighty works of God. He created the heavens and the earth. Amazingly, He cares about you! So you can trust in Him.

*O Lord, grant me the knowledge of You so I will trust you more in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Thursday's Path: Job 32:6 So Elihu, the son of Barachel the Buzite, answered and said: "I am young in years, and you are very old; Therefore I was afraid, And dared not declare my opinion to you.

PathWay: Job's young friend Elihu was frustrated. He felt he had something to say but did not feel that Job or his other friends would listen. Why? Simply because of his age. Many people over time have shared a similar frustration, feeling others aren't really listening to them or that they aren't taken seriously. People make decisions based on superficial conditions – age or gender, past relationships, other factors. However, hold on to your integrity.

*O Lord, help me live right irrespective of man's opinion in Jesus' name. PRAY! Friday's Path: Psa 37:23 The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, And He delights in his way.

PathWay: Though Fanny Crosby was born in 1820, Her life was a typical template for all. At times she felt weary, but she knew God would provide a "spring of joy." She experienced perfect rest and joy by trusting in "the fullness of His love." She knew she would spend eternity with her Father when she could praise Him "through endless ages." Be sure you trust God. Have faith. You can be confident

He will guide you and lead you all the way.

*O Lord, let my life radiates your glory in

Saturday's Path: Job 38:1 Then the LORD said:

spoke out of the "whirlwind" (here and Job 40:6). Whirlwinds also symbolize God's judgment, which is inevitable for those who displease or defy, or violate His Word. His power can sweep into their lives with sudden force like a whirlwind. Learn to depend on God. Have faith in Him. Look to Him for discernment and perspective.

*O Lord, help me depend on you more and more in Jesus' name.
