THE FEAR OF THE UNKNOWN

Psalm 34:4 I sought the LORD, and He heard me, And delivered me from all my fears.

The Portuguese felt it was critical to find a water route to Asia. The problem? Getting past Cape Bojador on the western coast of Africa. The cape's Arabic name was Father of Danger. Geographers labeled the waters beyond the cape as the Green Sea of Darkness.

Sailors were paralyzed by rumors. The cliffs along its coast were said to contain a magnetic force that could sink a vessel. There were stories that ships sailing by the cliffs could be struck with sheets of fire, that the water was boiling, and ships would be burned by the sun

and water.

But Portugal's Prince Henry the Navigator would not accept excuses. He commissioned a series of voyages to round Cape Bojador. The first 14 voyages failed. But in 1434, Henry made a radical decision, picking a man with no sailing experience to lead the fifteenth voyage. The man was Gil Eanes, a trusted, loyal aide.

Eanes's first voyage failed. But Henry ordered him to try again and do whatever was necessary. As they approached the cape, Eanes convinced the crew to keep sailing. They learned that the rumors were not true. The waters were calm. The barrier had been broken.

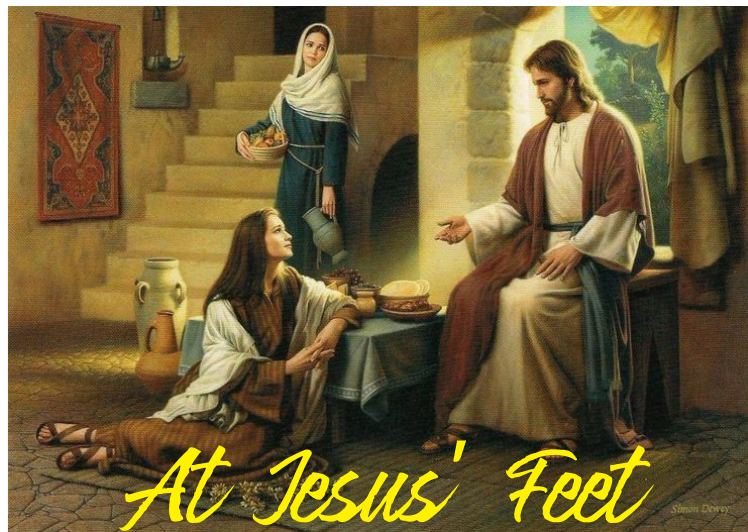

SUNDAY CLASS STUDY

A STUDY ABOUT WORRY AND ANXIETY - 1

Topic; Different types of Worry

Introduction: One thing you should know is that we know that life cannot be lived free from all sense of anxiety and concern. For example, parents always worry about their children, but the point is, you must not let Worry dominate your life. If you do, it will eat you up gradually. Note that it is easy to let our concerns become our cares and our forethoughts become our fear-thoughts. Any of the two is your choice. What then are the types of Worry?

1. People worry about things that have already happened (Phil 3:13) - This attitude is very futile! Worrying about what has already happened is like trying to saw sawdust! or putting the toothpaste back into the tube because past deeds cannot be undone or past words unsaid. Whatever it is, even if the past involves sin, obey the conditions of pardon, and God will abundantly forgive. Therefore, whatever the past said, instead of worrying about it, learn from it and take the matter to God in prayer.

Quote: "Yesterday is gone. Tomorrow has not yet come. We have only today. Let us begin." - Mother Theresa

2. People worry over things that will inevitably happen (Heb 6:17) - There are

some things that we cannot stop from happening. Que sera sera! (what will be will be). For example, you can't stop your children from marriage later on in their lives. Instead of worrying about how their marriage will turn out to be, take it to the Lord in Prayer. Instead of worrying about getting old and dying, spend your today as if you will die tomorrow.

Quote: What has been written will come to pass. You can't walk around it or dilute its originality.

3. Some people worry about things that will never happen (Matt 6:34) - Do you know that according to a survey, 80% of what we worry about never happens? Many people 'kill' themselves by Worrying about the travel they have not embarked on, the result of their exam, and things that have not happened, thereby robbing themselves of quality life.

DEVOTION TODAY With Pastor Christie



Monday's Path: Eph 3:1 For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for you Gentiles

PathWay: Drawing from Paul's letter to the Ephesians, he described how he had learned to depend on God. He prayed that God would make him a captive. He realized true freedom is only possible for those who have surrendered their lives to Him. Remember the lessons learned by Apostle Paul. Commit your life to Jesus. Make Him your Lord. Draw your strength and wisdom from Him.

*O Lord, I surrender my life anew to you. Use me as it pleases you in Jesus' name; PRAY!

Tuesday's Path: Psa 128:1 Blessed is every one who fears the LORD, Who walks in His ways.

PathWay: Some may think that fearing the Lord is an archaic concept or not appropriate for modern times. But this fear – reverence – is central to a life of blessing. In practical terms, what does it mean to fear the Lord? It means that we revere Him. We worship Him as God Almighty. We realize that He is our Creator, our Judge. Do you want God's blessings? Make sure you fear Him. Don't take Him for granted, but make Him the center of your life. Be serious about His Word. And seek first His Kingdom.

*O Lord, make me fear you more in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Wednesday's Path: Psa 129:4 The LORD is righteous; He has cut in pieces the cords of the wicked.

PathWay: This persecution was real. Yet he had discovered the right way to respond. He learned that he could trust God regardless of what others said or did. He is good. Looking back, he could rejoice because God had set him free! God had cut the cords and lifted the oppression. God had taken the burdens away. Are there things that bind you? Unhealthy habits? Financial needs? Troubled relationships? Health problems? Scars from things that happened in your youth or from conflicts you faced?

*O Lord, every cord of wickedness attached to my life is cut away in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Thursday's Path: Matt 7:15 "Beware of false prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves.

PathWay: Jesus warned us to "beware of the false

prophets." Realize that people may appear innocent or have ideas that seem acceptable but mask their real motivation. Be careful what you allow into your mind and what you believe. Remember, the devil and his demons constantly seek to attack you, spread confusion, and lure you into believing lies. So be on guard, and be careful what you allow to influence you.

*O Lord, help me to be on guard against falsehood in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Friday's Path: Luke 12:20 "But God said to him, 'Fool! This night your soul will be required of you; then whose will those things be which you have provided?'

PathWay: Jesus told the story of a similar man who spent his life pursuing short-term pleasures, unconcerned about eternity. As the man faced death, God called him a "fool" and asked him, "As for all that you have prepared, who will own it now?" Jesus warned that this is the fate of everyone who "stores up treasure for himself and is not rich in relation to God" (v. 21).

*O Lord, let me daily think of heaven in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Saturday's Path: Rom 1:21 because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.

PathWay: Paul said that the key to real wisdom is being willing to become foolish in the sight of the world. This does not mean playing practical jokes but believing God's Word and living according to His timeless promises. Don't believe what is popular or what others think is true. Recognize that "the wisdom of this world is foolishness to God" (1 Corinthians 3:19). Instead, commit to believing God's Word and trusting Him unconditionally. This may not be popular, but absolute faith is a key to receiving His blessings.

*O Lord, let me see more of You than the world in Jesus' name.
