Point: Be careful!!! Others might not think the way you does.

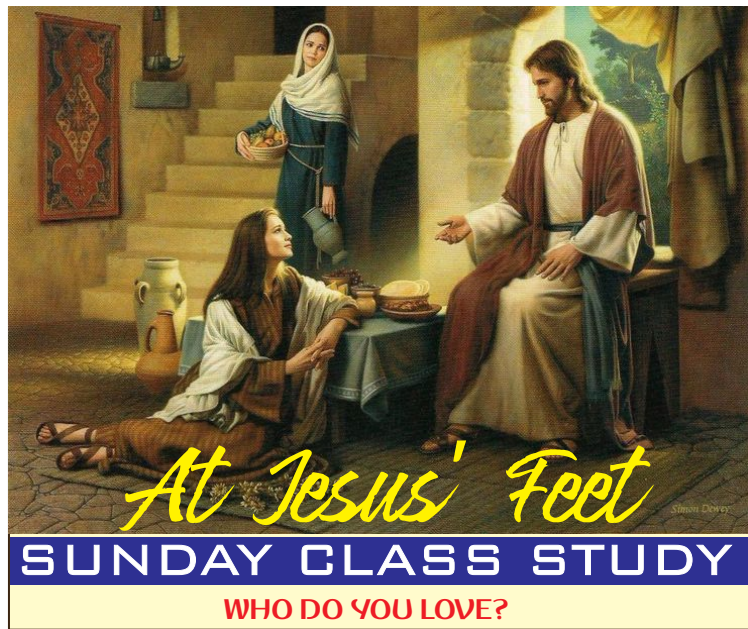
BEWARE OF CHILDREN (LOL)

2. Lovers of Money (2 Tim 3:2b) - To love money means always to place one's concern about money above other things. Balaam was a lover of money, and that was why it was able for him to be unfaithful. Judas was a lover of money and sold Jesus for 30 pieces of silver without thinking about its consequences. The sorcerer, Simon, was a money lover and cared less about dignity. The love of money is also a root of committing other sins. Instead, the Scriptures encourage us to see money as a servant we should be in control of and not allow it to enslave us.

3. Now, who should you love? (Matt 22:37-40) - Here, the Bible is clear on whom to love - God first and others secondly. If we all put this instruction into practice daily, the world will experience divine grace. Lastly, all Mercygatians and our leaders in various branches must see that the fire of true love is burning among brethren, and the family set up our church is known for is sustained. That is our strength and driving force.

Text: 2 Timothy 3:1-5

Introduction: When you ask a wife who she loves, she will quickly respond that she loves her husband and ditto a husband. But this is not the focus of this study today. Instead, the focus is to clearly understand who we pledge our allegiance to according to the Scriptures in the book 2 Timothy 3:1-5. This will allow us to understand what God requires from us. In this study, we will understand what the end times offer and answer one of the reasons why the world is running towards perdition.

1. Lovers of Self (2 Tim 3:1-2a) - To love self means always to place one's concerns above the concerns of others. But unfortunately, self-love often embroils us in sinful situations. When Cain killed Abel, he was more concerned for himself than his brother, and he did not consider his next step of murder. When David committed adultery with Bathsheba and orchestrated the cover-up, he was more concerned with himself than others and committed the evil act of murder. When Ahab took Nabob's vineyard, he was utterly absorbed in his selfishness and murdered without blinking his eyes. Note that the sin of loving self (selfishness) is the root of so many evil sins; in fact, it is the root of all murders. Instead, the Scriptures encourage us to love one

Monday's Path: Eze 12:23 "Tell them therefore, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "I will lay this proverb to rest, and they shall no more use it as a proverb in Israel." But say to them, "The days are at hand, and the fulfillment of every vision.

PathWay: God wanted everyone to know that only one interpretation counted, and that was His. They could live with any illusion that made sense to them and be comfortable with their conclusions, but none of these things would change His actions or the course of events. God had declared that "the time has come for every prophecy to be fulfilled!" Because of Israel's rebellion, God decided the time had come for fulfillment: "There will be no more delays" (v. 25)

*O Lord, fulfill all good prophecies in my life in Jesus' name; PRAY!

Tuesday's Path: Eze 8:16 So He brought me into the inner court of the LORD'S house; and there, at the door of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, were about twenty-five men with their backs toward the temple of the LORD and their faces toward the east, and they were worshiping the sun toward the east.

PathWay: Many Christians never enter this inner court. They stay outside content with a superficial relationship with God. They allow their lives to be controlled by the flesh instead of the Spirit. They cherish the things of this world rather than the things of God. Seek a more intimate relationship with God.

*O Lord, help me to improve my relationship with you in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Wednesday's Path: Psa 145:19 He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear their cry and save them.

PathWay: That same promise is true for you today. What problems do you face? What adversaries stand before you? Do you feel overwhelmed? In despair? Are you worried or afraid? Angry or bitter? You can call out to Him right now in any situation. Call on Him about the things you need, the problems you face, and the burdens of your life. He will hear your cry and save you.

*O Lord, fulfill my heart's desire in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Thursday's Path: Psa 146:6 Who made heaven and earth, The sea, and all that is in them; Who keeps truth forever,

PathWay: Keeping a promise is like a major deposit. The opposite is also true. Breaking a promise is like a major withdrawal. Those who don't keep their word find that others won't believe their promises. They have less credibility. These practical principles point back to the timeless truths in God's Word, which teach that we should always speak the truth

*O Lord, fulfill your promises in my life in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Friday's Path: Eze 13:10 "Because, indeed, because they have seduced My people, saying, 'Peace!' when there is no peace-and one builds a wall, and they plaster it with untempered mortar -

PathWay: Some of God's people had been encouraged by a message of peace. Everyone longed to hear it. The problem? It was not true. Many motivations existed for messages like this. The deceivers may intentionally have sought to mislead, but the deception also could have been well-intentioned, given by people guilty of wishful thinking. Regardless of the motivation, the words were not true, and listeners were being misled. We can be vulnerable to deception unless we focus our minds and hearts on truth.

*O Lord, help me to seek for only the truth in Jesus' name. PRAY!

Saturday's Path: Eze 26:3 "Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: 'Behold, I am against you, O Tyre, and will cause many nations to come up against you, as the sea causes its waves to come up.

PathWay: Gloating is a common reaction. This is a response when we take pleasure in the misfortune of others. It may seem understandable from a human perspective, but in God's sight, it's never acceptable.

*O Lord, rid me of all forms of gloating in Jesus' name.
