Therefore, their experience will be cloudy, dark, and unthankful. In fact, they only see mounting problems and the enemies' might because they cannot see the awesomeness of God. Therefore, when you invite these people into the Church, you ask them to come and experience the glory of God you are basking on. Why not ask someone to come and see?

3. The Son of God (John 1:34; Matt 14:32-33) - It is important never to forget their state: they wander on dry land, and the glory of God cannot reach them. Their Slave-Master is conning them, and they shamelessly worship a fellow mortal rather than God. They call their leaders God, pledge their allegiance to him, and ask their leaders what only God can give. They pay for their master's services and choose to elevate their leaders above the God of Israel. This is the primary reason we must all invite them to come and see the Son of God. He, who can free them from all bondages. Won't you ask them to come and see?

Review: Let your teacher know your method of inviting people to the Church

Text: John 1:43-46

Introduction: When talking to others about the gospel, you are doing what is far deeper than giving an invite to the Church. You are actually inviting them to come and see a whole lot of things about the depth of the mysteries of God. Asking people to the Church and bringing them into the fold is a calling you need to understand fully, to be able to do the work of an evangelist, which is the only assignment given to us all. Therefore, when you ask them to "come," you are indeed asking them to come and see:

1. The works of God (Psa 66:5-7) - It is not unreasonable to conclude that the more significant percentage of Christians today wander aimlessly without the knowledge of God. Thereby, most have become prey, hunted by the kingdom of darkness because of the total failure of their leaders, who are hell-bent on profiting off them. In such a state, they are lost and cannot experience the works of God in their lives. They seek the truth, roaming endlessly in the dry land of ignorance and slavery. When we all engage them to come and see, we ask them to come and see the works of God that we enjoy freely. Why not ask someone to come and see?

2. The glory of God (Isa 66:18; Eph 3:20) - Those living in the state we described earlier are definitely living under a closed heaven, and the ray of God's glory cannot reach them.

DEVOTION TODAY With Pastor Christie



Monday's Path: Psa 149:3 Let them praise His name with the dance; Let them sing praises to Him with the timbrel and harp.

Pathway: We respond to God's presence and all He has done for us. This is how David responded as the Ark of the Covenant was brought into Jerusalem. Think about all God has done for you: the joy of salvation, peace, blessings, answers to prayer, protection, meaning, purpose, forgiveness, and freedom. Don't be shy about expressing all God means to you. Share your testimony. Let others know you are a believer and don't be inhibited by what others may think.

**O Lord, I praise you for my salvation and all goodness I enjoy in you in Jesus' name; PRAY!*

Tuesday's Path: Hos 3:1 Then the LORD said to me, "Go again, love a woman who is loved by a lover and is committing adultery, just like the love of the LORD for the children of Israel, who look to other gods and love the raisin cakes of the pagans."

Pathway: When God asked Hosea to marry a harlot, he became a symbol. Through his example, God demonstrated that He wanted a love relationship with His people. No matter what they had done, God still loved them. He bought them. They no longer needed to be prostitutes but could enter a new relationship with Him. That is how our lives change when we enter that love relationship.

**O Lord, I praise you for making me yours in Jesus' name. PRAY!*

Wednesday's Path: Hos 4:6a My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.

Pathway: "Knowledge is power," Many believers fail to experience this potential because of a "lack of knowledge." They don't know so much. To begin to grasp God's promised riches, we need to immerse our lives in His Word and deepen our relationship with Him.

**O Lord, enable me to deepen my relationship with you in Jesus' name. PRAY!*

Thursday's Path: Hos 5:1a "Hear this, O priests! Take heed, O house of Israel! Give ear, O house of the king! For yours is the judgment.

Pathway: The Bible reminds us how easily we tend to criticize others, identify their mistakes, and judge them. In contrast, we can find ourselves blind to our weaknesses and ready to justify our actions and thoughts. Be careful before you criticize others. Be honest with God. Let Him examine your heart, thoughts, attitudes, and actions.

**O Lord, help me build my relationship with you in Jesus' name. PRAY!*

Friday's Path: Heb 9:28a so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many.

Pathway: The gift has been offered and what is left is to accept without any obligation. Note that salvation was not offered to us because of our good deeds or on merit. It was offered freely. The time is ripe for turning a new leaf and committing to Jesus Christ, who died for your sin. He is waiting.

**O Lord, I rededicate my life to you in Jesus' name. PRAY!*

Saturday's Path: Hos 6:3 Let us know, Let us pursue the knowledge of the LORD. His going forth is established as the morning; He will come to us like the rain, Like the latter and former rain to the earth.

Pathway: God allows us to make choices every day. We choose what to do and say, where to go, and what to do with our time and resources. He allows us to reject Him or follow Him. So, what are to do? First, we need to know God. We should not just know about Him but have an intimate, personal relationship with Him.

**O Lord, reveal yourself to me more in Jesus' name.*
