


Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap. For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life - Gal 6:7-8

The truth is so simple we can take it for granted: We always reap what we sow. Farmers never would argue this fact. They know that if they want corn, they must plant seeds of corn. If they want wheat, they need to plant seeds of wheat. And so on. They also know they will not reap any crops if they do not plant seeds.

Paul wrote that this same principle applies to every phase of life. Our harvests depend on what we sow. This means that what we receive in our lives (our harvest) depends on what we do or say (what we sow). These are our

investments.

In spiritual terms, we can determine what kind of fruit we will receive. If we spend our lives pursuing pleasure, popularity, or other earthly rewards, we only will reap these kinds of returns. As a result, we may not receive spiritual riches.

God's blessings, both in this life and in the life to come, are for those who sow to the Spirit. These are people who first seek His Kingdom. They separate themselves from the corruption in this world. They fill their minds with His Word and are consumed with a desire to please Him.

If you want to reap spiritual riches, seek to sow in the Spirit. Then, sow abundantly into His Kingdom so that you may be blessed with a bountiful harvest.

TODAY'S WORSHIP SONG



SUNDAY CLASS STUDY

THE ASSAULT ON WORSHIP - 2

Topic: What true Worship possess Text: John 4:23-24

Introduction: Last week, we studied that one of the primary objectives of worship change agents is to renovate and restructure the Church's worship practices to suit the pleasure of their members, and their ultimate goal is numbers - nothing to do with the salvation of souls. The four types of Worship are explained in detail. Today, we will understand what true Worship possesses.

1. True Worship possesses the right audience with proper focus (God) - According to the Scriptures, to have true Worship, worshippers must have proper focus, that is, God. Unfortunately, today, the Church is full of people and leader who believe that morals and righteousness is not part of Christian living. Because they do not know God and the Scriptures, they act and preach that prostitution, riot living, and shameless acts are not a hindrance to gaining heaven. However, the fact remains that the Word of God cannot be moved, changed, edited, erased, or added to.

2. True Worship possesses the right audience with proper attitude (in Spirit) - Worshipping in Spirit takes real effort.

Unfortunately, the current climate in the Church tends to treat Worship as a time of entertaining the worshipper and catering to the worshiper's wants. As a result, many worshippers have lost the deep, reverent mind set to please God and not self. This lax attitude is especially evident in the change that has come over many congregations with regard to dressing to the Church, music played in Worship services, and the quality of sermons.

3. True Worship possesses the right audience with proper actions (in truth) - The current assault on Worship includes an attempt to dodge the clear meaning of the expression" "in truth." Some falsely say that "in truth" is simply a Hebraism, meaning to worship sincerely and devotedly. However, worshipping God" in truth" is equivalent to "doing truth," which entails "deeds" or external actions which God prescribes. Therefore, you cannot claim to worship God" in truth" without living by the truth code - the Word of God.
